Memory Verses for Children

- I. Verses that deal with loving God and our neighbor
 - 1. Loving God and our neighbor as ourselves are the two most important things we can do (Mat 22:37-40).
 - A. Here are verses to memorize for these most important things.

 Mat 22:37-38 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment.
 Joh 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.
 - and his commandments are not grievous.ii. Loving our neighbor as ourselves (the golden rule)
 - □ **Gal 5:14** For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

□ 1Jn 5:3 - For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments:

- □ **Jam 2:8** If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:
- \Box Luk 6:31 And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.
- II. Verses that deal with good character
 - 1. Faith, virtue, knowledge, temperance, patience, godliness, brotherly kindness, and charity are eight Christian virtues that parents should teach their children (2Pe 1:5-7).
 - □ **2Pe 1:5** And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge;
 - □ **2Pe 1:6** And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness:
 - □ **2Pe 1:7** And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
 - 2 Here are verses to memorize for each of these virtues

 - □ **Heb 11:6** But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

 - □ **Pro 3:5** Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

 - □ **Isa 26:3** Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.
 - \Box Isa 26:4 Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

G. Brotherly kindness

H. Charity (love)
