Free Will Killed Jesus Christ

- I. Believers in Sovereign Grace are often accused of believing that man doesn't have freewill.
 - 1. This is simply false (though it's true of some Calvinists).
 - 2. Man does have free will to make choices in his life.
 - A. **2Sa 24:12** Go and say unto David, Thus saith the LORD, I offer thee three things; CHOOSE thee one of them, that I may do it unto thee.
 - B. **Pro 3:31** Envy thou not the oppressor, and CHOOSE none of his ways.
- II. But fallen man doesn't have the ability to choose to make himself righteous and choose to receive eternal life.
 - 1. This is because fallen man is spiritually dead.
 - A. Eph 2:1 And you hath he quickened, who were <u>dead</u> in trespasses and sins;
 - B. Dead men don't do anything and spiritually dead men don't do anything spiritual.
 - C. ***Dead man in the river analogy***
 - 2. Fallen man WILL NOT and CANNOT seek after God.
 - A. **Psa 10:4** <u>The wicked</u>, through the pride of his countenance, <u>will not seek after</u> <u>God</u>: God is not in all his thoughts.
 - B. Rom 3:10 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:
 - C. Rom 3:11 There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God.
 - D. **Rom 3:12** They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.
 - 3. Fallen man is free from righteousness, not free to it.
 - A. Rom 6:20 For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness.
 - 4. Therefore, the salvation of fallen man is NOT ACCORDING TO HIS WILL.
 - A. **Rom 9:16** So then <u>it is not of him that willeth</u>, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy.
- III. Fallen man will choose to reject Jesus Christ if he is offered the chance to receive Him.
 - 1. **Mar 15:9** But Pilate answered them, saying, <u>Will ye that I release unto you the King of the Jews?</u>
 - 2. Mar 15:10 For he knew that the chief priests had delivered him for envy.
 - 3. **Mar 15:11** But the chief priests moved the people, that he should rather release Barabbas unto them.
 - 4. **Mar 15:12** And Pilate answered and said again unto them, <u>What will ye then that I shall</u> do unto him whom ye call the King of the Jews?
 - 5. Mar 15:13 And they cried out again, Crucify him.
 - 6. **Mar 15:14** Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, Crucify him.
 - 7. Luk 23:25 And he released unto them him that for sedition and murder was cast into prison, whom they had desired; but <u>he delivered Jesus to their will</u>.
 - 8. Fallen man's free will nailed Jesus to the cross and fallen man's free will is no different today.
- IV. The salvation of the elect is according to God's will, not their will.
 - 1. **Eph 1:4** According as <u>he hath chosen</u> us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:
 - 2. Eph 1:5 <u>Having predestinated us</u> unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,
 - 3. **Eph 1:11** In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, <u>being predestinated according to</u> the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

- V. Once an elect child of God has been regenerated and given eternal life, then, and only then, can he choose to seek and follow God.
 - 1. **Eph 1:13** In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, (verse 13 comes *after* verses 4-11)
 - 2. **1Th 1:4** Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God.
 - 3. **1Th 1:5** For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.
 - 4. **1Th 1:6** And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost:
