Jehovah's Witnesses are Not Christians

- I. Jehovah's Witnesses claim to be the true followers of Christ.
- II. They are not followers of the true Jesus Christ at all.
- III. According to their perversion of the Bible, the New World Translation, Jesus Christ is not God, but is a created god.
 - 1. **Joh 1:1 (New World Translation)** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was a god.
 - 2. **Joh 1:14** (New World Translation) So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father; and he was full of divine favor and truth.
 - 3. **1Ti 3:16** (New World Translation) Indeed, the sacred secret of this godly devotion is admittedly great: 'He was made manifest in flesh, was declared righteous in spirit, appeared to angels, was preached about among nations, was believed upon in the world, was received up in glory.'
- IV. The KJV plainly declares that Jesus Christ is God.
 - 1. **Joh 1:1** (**KJV**) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
 - 2. **Joh 1:14 (KJV)** And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
 - 3. **1Ti 3:16 (KJV)** And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: <u>God was manifest in the flesh</u>, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.
- V. They claim to be Jehovah's witnesses, but they are certainly not by the words of Jehovah Himself.
 - 1. **Isa 43:10 (KJV)** Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.
 - 2. Isa 43:11 (KJV) I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour.
 - 3. **Hos 13:4 (KJV)** Yet <u>I am the LORD</u> thy God from the land of Egypt, and <u>thou shalt know</u> no god but me: for <u>there is no saviour beside me</u>.
- VI. The "Jesus" of the Jehovah's Witnesses who is a created god is no saviour, but is "another Jesus."
 - 1. **2Co 11:3 (KJV)** But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
 - 2. **2Co 11:4** (**KJV**) For if he that cometh preacheth <u>another Jesus</u>, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
