  - a. "Every purpose is established by counsel: and with good advice make war." (Pro 20:18)
  - b. "For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counsellors there is safety." (Pro 24:6)
- 3. We should not be quick to fight, lest we end up with egg on our faces again.
  - a. "Go not forth hastily to strive, lest thou know not what to do in the end thereof, when thy neighbour hath put thee to shame." (Pro 25:8)
- 4. We should not be bombing and murdering people who have done us no harm.
  - a. "Strive not with a man without cause, if he have done thee no harm." (Pro 3:30)
- 5. We should stay out of other people's wars and problems.
  - a. "He that passeth by, and meddleth with strife belonging not to him, is like one that taketh a dog by the ears." (Pro 26:17)
  - b. "It is an honour for a man to cease from strife: but every fool will be meddling." (Pro 20:3)
  - c. "But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters." (1Pe 4:15)
- 6. We don't even know who used the chemical weapons in Syria, therefore we should not be making a hasty decision to go to war without knowledge.
  - a. "Also, that the soul be without knowledge, it is not good; and he that hasteth with his feet sinneth." (Pro 19:2)
- 7. Our government have proven themselves to be liars in the past (WMDs in Iraq); why would we believe them this time? Is there anything new under the sun?
  - a. "If a ruler hearken to lies, all his servants are wicked." (Pro 29:12)
  - b. "The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun." (Ecc 1:9)
- 8. It is wicked to lie in order to murder people and to enrich one's self.
  - a. "The getting of treasures by a lying tongue is a vanity tossed to and fro of them that seek death." (Pro 21:6) Is that what's going on?
  - b. "In thee are men that carry tales to shed blood: and in thee they eat upon the mountains: in the midst of thee they commit lewdness." (Eze 22:9) Is this what's going on?
- 9. Have our leaders changed their crooked, lying nature?
  - a. "That which is crooked cannot be made straight: and that which is wanting cannot be numbered." (Ecc 1:15)

- b. "Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? then may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil." (Jer 13:23)
- 10. We should learn from history.
  - a. "That which hath been is now; and that which is to be hath already been; and God requireth that which is past." (Ecc 3:15)
- 11. It's not just Obama; he is just following in the footsteps of his predecessor.
  - a. "For the transgression of a land many are the princes thereof: but by a man of understanding and knowledge the state thereof shall be prolonged." (Pro 28:2)
- 12. Some stupid people never learn, no matter how many times they repeat the same mistakes and are punished severely for it. Let's not be some of them.
  - a. "Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, yet will not his foolishness depart from him." (Pro 27:22)

  - a. "The words of wise men are heard in quiet more than the cry of him that ruleth among fools." (Ecc 9:17)
